Eligibility

This is the annual Parker County Secondary Student Art Show sponsored by Weatherford Art Association. All Parker County art students grades 6-12 including a special category for Gifted and Talented students are eligible for this competition.

Format

Original works only, no photocopies. All 2 and 3-dimensional works are acceptable.

Size

No size restrictions apply.

Categories

Works will be broken into grade level and art levels.

Art 1 – grades 6-7-8

Art 1 – grades 9-12

Art 2 – grades 9-12

Art 3/4 – grades 10-12

Advanced Placement grades 10-12

Sculpture – all levels

Photography all levels

Gifted and Talented Group.

Awards

Cash awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each category with an overall Best of Show Award. Monetary amounts will be determined by the number of entries.

Entry Form and Fee

Art teachers may only submit 10 student entries per category. If a teacher teaches more than one level, they may submit 10 in that level.

A completed, signed entry form must accompany each art piece. Teachers may present a master list instead of individual forms. A copy of the form must be on the backside of each entry for identification purposes. Entry fees are \$1 per entry with 2 entries per student acceptable.

Display and Sale

Art pieces may be for sale, please indicate price or mark NFS on entry form. WAA does take a 20% commission for each sale so price accordingly. WAA and the Doss will handle all art with the utmost care and are not responsible for any damage to art for the duration of the show. All art must remain on display for the duration of the show unless other arrangements are made between the teacher and WAA. WAA reserves the right to combine judged levels if submissions are low. All student art pieces are to be delivered to the Doss Heritage and Cultural Center at 1400 Texas Dr., on March 9 or 10th, 2018.

Judge

This years' judge is retired artist and teacher Patti Beck.

BONUS

To help spread the awards and get the community involved in this show, all spectators may vote for their favorite artwork/student for \$1 per vote. That money will be presented to the students during the awards presentation.
