Currently, Mr. Hogue is a member of Trinity Art Guild, Irving Art Assoc., and Pastel Society of the Southwest.

Johnny Mahto Hogue was born and raised in Texas but has always admired the colors and ambiance of the Southwest, especially Native Americans and their home style and customs.

He has been interested and involved in art since an early age and is a self-taught artist, studying color, composition and anatomy. He is inspired by the Old Masters as well as the Modern Masters, (Norman Rockwell, Andrew Wyeth and Daniel Greene).

He is adept in acrylics, oils, pastels, charcoals and pen and ink, accepts commissions, sells original artwork and giclees, etc (see his website for contact info). He favors oils because of the perfection of the colors he desires and achieves in accomplishing the reality of the subject, which shows in all of his art works. He never stops studying, has won many awards, mostly First Place and People's Choice. Every day he studies, paints, studies and paints--It is his love. Johnny “Mahto” Hogue offers private lessons at his studio in Rhome, TX., and group lessons in Bedford, TX., teaches watercolor at Tarrant County College and tutors workshops.

As a graduate of Poly High School she earned a Bachelor of Science in Education as well as well as Masters in Special Education at the University of North Texas. Realizing that teachers seem to be lifelong learners, Cindi later studied to receive certifications in math

and the Principalship.

Cindi is currently married to Richard Neverdousky, Mayor of Willow Park. He is from Connecticut but got here as quickly as he could. She and Richard have been married 10 years and have a blended family.
