The annual Texas & Neighbors competition is back for its 32nd year! This prestigious five-state competition pulls entries representative of the best of American art. Sponsored annually by the Irving Art Association and the Irving Arts Center. The **2017 Texas & Neighbors Regional Art Exhibition** is open to all artists 18 and older living in Texas, Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico and Oklahoma. Up to three works of art may be entered by an artist for an entry fee of \$40 (\$35 for IAA members).

\$9,000 in prizes! Artists may also earn signature status by exhibiting in five shows. Juror for the 2017 exhibition is **Michael Holter**.
