Registration will be on November 29, from 2:00pm-5:00pm and December 1, from 10:00am-2:00pm. The show will be judged by Randy Meadow on December 6th.



Texas western artist Randy Meadow says he owes her art career to former British Prime Minister Winston Churchill. "While reading a Churchill biography in 1991, I stopped and meditated on her words, 'When I paint, nothing else exists.' I wanted desperately to go there...regularly." The former marketer and speaking began painting that day.

Meadow graduated from the University of Oklahoma in 1985 with a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree, but initially chose a different career course in a variety of businesses.

"I pestered Buck Taylor (watercolor artist) at a Fort Worth Stock Show in 1992 and asked him who were the best watercolor artists, then proceeded to study all the works of Winslow Homer, John Singer Sargent, Paul Cezanne, and others. They were my early teaches. I figured, why not learn from some of the greats?"

## Artist of the Month & Year Rules

### ARTICLE VIII Artist of the Month

**Section 1. Artist of the Month.** Artist of the Month shall be open to a vote of voting-members only. First place winners will not be eligible to enter competition for the remainder of the competition year (June thru May). Artwork must be original and have been created within the past three years.

**Section 2. Artist of the Year.** First place winners of the Artist of the Month Competition shall compete for Artist of the Year at the June Regular Meeting of the Membership. Entries shall be their Artist of the Month winning entry, unless unavailable.
