The 22nd Annual Juried Rio Brazos Art Exhibition opens at 3 p.m. on April 14, 2019, at the Dora Lee Langdon Cultural & Educational Center Concert Hall in Granbury, Texas. The exhibition is supported by Tarleton State University, Granbury Arts Alliance, the City of Granbury and numerous local and regional businesses. The coordinators of this event plan to create an atmosphere that will inspire, educate and entertain as well as attract quality art and discriminating buyers.

Eligible artwork will be selected at the discretion of the juror, Benedict Sum of Angelo State University. Works may be grouped according to the type of media received. Approximately \$5,000 in cash awards will be given. All work entered must be available for sale. Dora Lee Langdon Center will conduct all sales during the exhibition. Price, not including tax, must be listed on entry. A 25% commission is collected upon sale.
